

**MOST IMPORTANT HISTORICAL DATES
REGARDING THE BUILDINGS OF THE
SOUTH BRITAIN CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH**

- 1761** South Britain was granted winter preaching privileges
- 1766** South Britain was accepted as a separate Ecclesiastical Society
- 1768** Work began on the first meeting house
- 1771 - 1772**
First services were held in the new meeting house
- 1825** The second meeting house was built
- 1851** The present parsonage was purchased
- 1869** Massive renovations were made to the meeting house
- 1902** A stained glass window was installed behind the pulpit
- 1960** Renovations were made to the original parish house along with the first addition consisting of the gathering room and classrooms below
- 1986** A second addition was made to the parish house including three offices and a classroom.
