1761	South Britain was granted winter preaching privileges
1766	South Britain was accepted as a separate Ecclesiastical Society
1768	Work began on the first meeting house
1771 - 17	772 First services were held in the new meeting house
1825	The second meeting house was built
1851	The present parsonage was purchased
1869	Massive renovations were made to the meeting house
1902	A stained glass window was installed behind the pulpit
1960	Renovations were made to the original parish house along with the first addition consisting of the gathering room and classrooms below
1986	A second addition was made to the parish house including three offices and a classroom.
